**STANDARDS AND PROCEDURES FOR AWARDING SCHOLARSHIPS**

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of the GEWN Scholarship Fund is to assist in the college education of Georgia female *leaders of tomorrow*. GEWN will award two \$3,000 scholarships for the 2009-2010 academic year to female, non-traditional, full-time students who are attending or planning to attend a metropolitan Atlanta accredited college or university in a four-year undergraduate program of study. Non-traditional is defined as a student who is at least 24 years old.

**CRITERIA — TO QUALIFY FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP, THE APPLICANT MUST**

- Be a female at least 24 years of age by August 1, 2009.
- Be enrolled as a full-time student for the 2009-2010 academic year in a four-year undergraduate program of study at a metropolitan Atlanta accredited college or university *and* have completed at least one year of college.
- Have a college grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Have demonstrated leadership abilities in school, work and/or community.

**AND MUST SUBMIT**

1. GEWN Scholarship Application
2. A current resume or biographical statement
3. Two letters of recommendation in individual envelopes (signed over the sealed flap) that document leadership accomplishments from any of the following people: professor, dean or other administrator, counselor, employer, or person of similar stature.
4. Typed essay (up to 500 words) answering the question, "What are your professional/community goals and objectives after you complete your college education?"
5. An official transcript from college submitted by the school in a sealed envelope.

**HOW TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS**

The applicant must submit the application with proper supporting documents to be postmarked no later than April 15, 2009 to the Co-Chair of the GEWN Scholarship Committee. It is imperative that the applicant submits documents in one packet and on time. It is suggested that packets be sent by registered or certified mail to ensure delivery. Send to:

**SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS**

The GEWN Scholarship Committee will review all applications and make selections. GEWN will award two \$3,000 scholarships for the 2009-2010 academic year. Announcement of the awards will be made in June 2009 and recipients will be honored at the GEWN Scholarship Award Luncheon in October 2009. The GEWN Scholarship Committee may interview top applicants and select one or more alternates in the event a recipient is unable to use the scholarship.
